2005 Overview

2005 is over and 2006 is under way. I am sure many of you have noticed that I have missed a several issues with my column. The end of the year and the beginning of a new year are always a little hectic.

I am going to give you a little overview of some of the things that we have done over the past year.

First Sheriff's Office serves document for the court, such as Summons, Complaints, Notices and Subpoenas. The law allows us to charge a fee for serving the process and charging for mileage to do so. We served 889 sets of papers and collected \$17178.06 for serving these documents . We drove over 26142 miles serving the papers. My office also collected over \$20758.89 in Judgments that was paid to businesses or individuals.

There were 107 warrants of arrest and bench warrants served and we collected over \$10538.43 in bond or unpaid fines. There are still 166 active warrants or bench warrants in Turner County.

The county spent \$39725.46 for incarcerating of adult prisoners and \$23161.62 for detaining juveniles.

There were over 3000 calls for assistance. We investigated 134 accidents, 33 DWI's, 14 burglary's, 44 damage to property, 26 thefts and 19 assaults and 14 domestic's assaults just to name a few.
